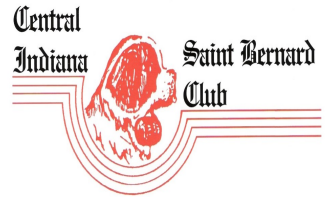

From: Nick Little, Cluster Coordinator on behalf of the Cluster Committee and individual clubs.

As everyone will appreciate, we are living through a great period of uncertainty that will hopefully be a once-in-a-lifetime occurrence that future generations will learn about in their history lessons.

Against this background of uncertainty, your cluster committee is pressing ahead with preparations for our event in the hope that emergency measures put in place will be removed or reduced in impact by the time Memorial Day weekend comes around.

We are doing all we can to ensure that you, your families, friends and dogs attending will be safe, and we have no adverse impact on the local population. We ask everyone to respect and comply with CDC and other guidelines to help avoid contamination and spread of the disease. *If you enter the shows but develop symptoms, please stay home and don't risk infecting others.*

Our show site is in a rural setting with no nearby sub-divisions. The show will be outdoors with grooming under a pavilion structure that has no containing walls, thus well-ventilated. Camping spaces are also well-separated. We believe there are no current local, state or federal emergency rules in place that prevent the show going ahead.

However, since the pandemic is possibly still in its early stages, things could change. The cluster committee will be discussing the situation weekly between now and the end of April when we will make a final stop/go decision. We will be taking input, advice and guidance from the site owners (Lima KC) and from local officials. We will immediately let you know if there is a decision to cancel the shows.

We plan to be able to refund all entry monies and RV reservation payments received in the event of a cancellation which will be announced before the closing date for entries of Wednesday, May 6, 2020.

Let's all hope the pandemic can be speedily resolved and that we can have a wonderful show as planned. If not, we'll be back at it again next year!

Please stay safe in the meantime and I look forward to welcoming you all to Lima over the Memorial Day weekend.

## AKC National Owner-Handled Series

*(Remember to check the box near the bottom of the entry form)*

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers\*, household members and current assistants\*\* to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show.** Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled Group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/ Variety.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners. • If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.
- The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners competition.
- \*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- \*\*A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

## **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION**

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present or a first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show, are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class. Must notify the Superintendent/Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show. AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Phone (919) 233- 9767 or E-mail: juniors@akc.org. Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

**NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE SENIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN JUNIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN SENIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**MASTER CLASS:** This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

**JUNIORS WITH A DOG ALSO ENTERED IN ANOTHER CLASS OFFERED AT THIS SHOW WHO SUBSTITUTE A DOG NOT ENTERED IN THIS SHOW MUST REMIT THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ONLY AND JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AS AN ADDITIONAL CLASS ENTRY FEE. ### **Dogs 4 Months and over but under 6 Months AKC Sanctioned Beginner Puppy Competition**

**Section 1** - Classifications. The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for Saint Bernards only.

**Section 2** - Entry and Eligibility Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed or member dog shows at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for all entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin. • FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.

### **FOUR TO SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY**

**The Tri-State Saintly Cluster** will assume no responsibility for any personal injury or death to any person, theft, damage or loss of either personal property; or injury or death of any animal whether at or on the show grounds.

**Members of the Cluster Committee and designated members of each club** will be making rounds through the grooming, show grounds and camping areas periodically. Any infractions or indications that dogs are not being properly cared for or the areas not kept clean will be subject to a possible Event Committee Hearing.

**Bred by Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility (revised 09/02)**

The Bred by Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are: Six months of age or older as of the first date of the show. Not Champion of record on the date of closing of entries for the show. Individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and owner of record of this dog.

In any subsequent classes for which the dog from the Bred by Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

**Amateur - Owner - Handler Class (effective as of 1/1/2009)**

Chapter 3, Section 7 - The Amateur - Owner - Handler Class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 1

## **CGC & CGCA and Trick Dog Tests** **Sunday, May 24, 2020**

The American Kennel Club's Canine Good Citizen Program is a two part program that is designed to (1) teach responsible dog ownership to owners and (2) certify dogs that have the training & demeanor to be reliable, well-behaved members of their families and communities. The purpose of the Canine Good Citizen Program is to ensure that our favorite companion, the dog, can be a respected member of the community because it is trained and conditioned to act mannerly in the home, in public places and in the presence of other dogs. The Canine Good Citizen Test is a test of your dog's manners and training. It is not a competition and does not require the owner/handler and dog to perform with precision. Handlers may talk to their dogs throughout the test but cannot offer food or a toy. The Canine Good Citizen Test is open to purebred dogs - both registered, unregistered and mixed breed dogs that are 6 months old or older. At check-in, the owner or handler must present a current rabies certificate. A rabies tag is not sufficient proof of rabies vaccination. All tests must be performed on-leash. Dogs should wear well-fitted buckle or slip collars made of either leather, fabric or chain. Special training collars or devices (e.g. pinch collars or "head halters") are not permitted. The leash should be made of leather or fabric. Dogs must be healthy, in good condition and clean to pass the test. A dog whose appearance has been noticeably affected by a medical condition may pass the test, provided at check-in, the owner presents a letter of explanation and release from the dog's veterinarian.

---

### **The dog must pass each of the following 10 test categories for CGC**

1. Accepting a friendly stranger.
  2. Sitting politely for petting.
  3. Appearance and grooming.
  4. Walking on a loose leash.
  5. Walking through a crowd.
  6. Sit and down on command, stay in place.
  7. Come when called.
  8. Reaction to another dog.
  9. Reactions to visual and auditory distractions.
  10. Supervised separation.

### **The dog must have a CGC and pass each of the following 10 test categories for CGCA and 3 dogs taking the test**

1. Stands, sits or lies down and waits under control of owner: fills out paperwork or has a snack or visits with another person.
2. Walks on a loose lead (not in a ring) does not pull. Makes left, right turn, stops and goes at a fast and slow pace.
3. Walks on a loose lead through a crowd. Tested in a real crowd. Not a ring.
4. Dog walks past distractions with dogs present, does not pull.
5. Sit - Stay in a small group (3 other people with dogs). Informal circle. Dogs on owner's left side, on lead, 3 feet apart. At least 30 seconds staying in group.
6. Dog allows person to who is carrying something. Such as a, computer bag, backpack. "May I pet your dog?" Item will be placed on the ground before person pets the dog.
7. Leave it. Dog walks by food and follows owners instructions. Food maybe placed by the evaluator on the floor or ground, in a food dish with a wire cover.

8. Down or Sit stay - Distance is owner's choice. Dog is on a 20 foot line. Owner walks away with back to dog, owner picks up an item placed on the ground or chair by the evaluator and returns to the dog. Item could be backpack, training bag or clipboard
9. Recall with distractions present. Handler goes out 20 feet off center and calls the dog. Dog is on a 20 foot line.

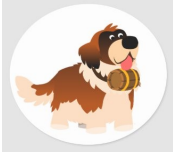

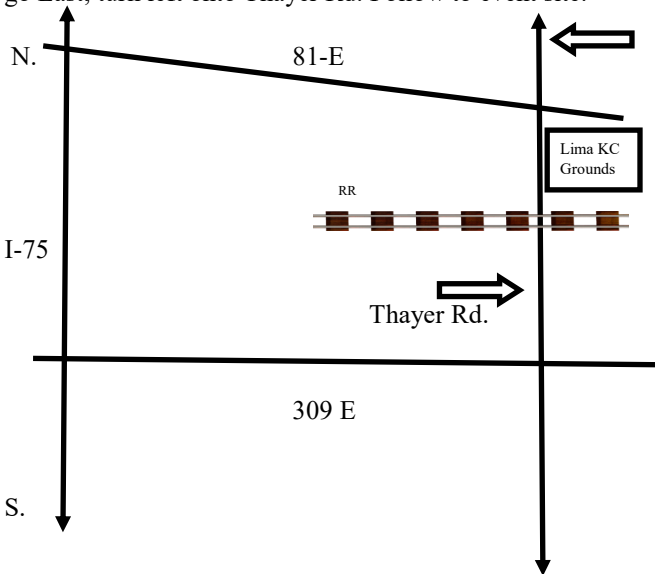

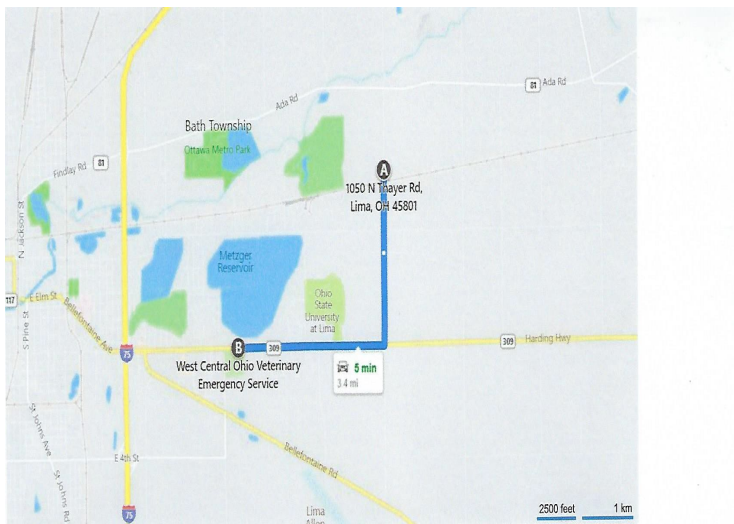
